Postponement of the CCA Token Summit 2020

We have been closely monitoring the ongoing COVID-19 virus situation over the past few weeks. Even though no new infections have been recorded in Liechtenstein over the past weeks and the Government of the Principality of Liechtenstein has further loosened the restrictions in the past days, the world-wide situation remains challenging. We feel for those countries that are so severely affected and hit by COVID-19.

Many of our guests and speakers from North America, South America and Asia are still confronted with a high uncertainty about their travel plans. This remaining uncertainty still makes it hard to properly plan the Token Summit with physical presence in Liechtenstein. The option of a virtual conference has been intensively discussed. However, we came to the conclusion that a virtual conference does not offer the same possibilities to foster the special atmosphere we have originally intended.

The organization committee of the Token Summit therefore has now decided that the Token Summit 2020 will be postponed a second time. The Token Summit will take place earliest in March 2021. The new date will be communicated as soon as possible.
